CAMP SAFETY

The most important part of camp is the safety of our youth. The camp committee would like to ensure all of you that all the appropriate measures have been taken.

First and foremost, there will be no pets, no alcohol, and no smoking on the camp premises. For those of you who are smokers, you must leave the camp to smoke. All cigarette butts are to be taken home with you also.

All Leaders who are attending BC 10, including camp staff, must be a registered member and have a current PRC. Camp committee will have access to the MMS system for verification of registration and PRCs.

Because of events that the youth may be participating in at camp, it is recommended that a PARENT/GUARDIAN CONSENT FORM FOR CATEGORY 3 ACTIVITIES be signed and brought to camp. A copy of the consent form can be found on the Scouts Canada website. Those who do not have this form on arrival to camp will not be able to participate in events that are deemed a Category 3 event. Let's try and not disappoint our youth!

South/North Waterloo Area Medical Ventures will be our First Aid Team. They are highly recognizable as they will be the only Scouters with blue shirts. Our Medical Ventures are trained for medical emergencies. There is also a phone at the Ranger Station if and when it is needed.

There will be no electronic devices brought to camp. If you are in possession of a device (radios, cell phone, ipods, mp3 players etc.), it shall be turned over to the Camp Chief for the duration of the weekend.

No Scout will be in possession of any type of weapon. If a Scout is found to be in possession of a weapon, they will be asked to leave camp immediately.

Finally, camp is about having fun. There is no reason why we all can not have fun, and be safe at the same time!

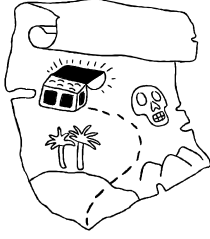

Driving Directions:

From the 401:

- *Take the Drumbo exit #250 & travel East on RR 29 towards Drumbo*
- *At 4 way stop, go straight*
- *Approx. 2km out of town go over Nith River bridge and Peacehaven is on the right*

From Kitchener- Waterloo:

- *401 West towards London take exit #268*
- *Go left at lights on hwy 97*
- *At first set of lights, turn left on Northumberland Drive*
- *Go to 'T' intersection at end*
- *Turn right onto Piper St & go to the end*
- *Turn left on Brant Oxford Rd and go to stop sign at Drumbo RR 29*
- *Turn right and go approx. 4 km*
- *Camp is on your left just before the Nith River Bridge*
- *(This route is okay if you know your way around the area, otherwise, take the 401, it is longer, but easier; especially with a care full of youth!)*

From Brantford/Hamilton:

- *Take 403 West to Hwy 25 (right on Middle Town Line)*
- *Turn left on Hwy 2 into Princeton*
- *In Princeton, turn right on Hwy 3 toward Drumbo*
- *In Drumbo, turn right at 4 way stop on RR 29*

Go 2km & just over the Nith River Bridge, the camp is on the right



Saturday Night Campfire

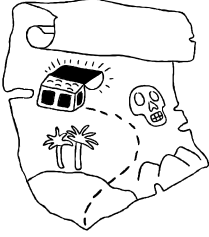
Does your group have a favorite song or skit????

We would like to encourage anyone who plays the guitar to bring it along with them to campfire. We have a few songs lined up – see if you know them!

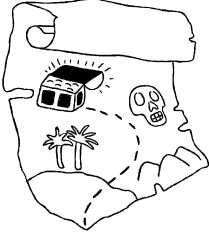


Events

The Camp Ranger will be inspecting all booked camp sites to ensure Peacehaven Scout Camp is left clean. When the ranger gives the 'okay', he will give you a bright pink piece of paper allowing you to exit, and prevent any problems in the parking lot with our Ushers. When our Ushers see that you have the paper from the Ranger, he/she will allow you to exit. You cannot leave Peacehaven Scout Camp without having this bright pink piece of paper.
